



Agricultural Research Management System










Activ-MyP

The "Activity-MyP" section displays all research activities within the user's directorate. When the button is clicked, a list of activities is shown, categorized by key headings such as activity title, commodity, responsibility, duration, implementing centers, and testing locations.

Additionally, based on the researcher's role, each activity will have a button to view reports and, if the researcher has the necessary authority, a separate button to submit reports.








MyActis:

"MyActis" is a button that lists all your research activities where you are mentioned as the principal investigator and/or responsible researcher. If you are assigned as a reporting researcher or PI, the system automatically provides a report filling form, enabling you to submit reports for those activities. Additionally, the system suggests research activities associated with your name, cross-referenced with the database. You can then accept or reject these suggested activities as yours.









Research Directorate
